JOINING TOGETHER IN PRAYER:

We want to raise the needs of our community and our world before God (Philippians 4:6). If you have prayer requests, please bring them to a pastor or any member of the Congregational Care Committee.

- Lately, members of our community have been in and out of hospital for diagnosis, care, or surgery. Pray that the presence of God, who took on human frailty, would be a source of hope and comfort for those whose bodies at times may feel frail.
- Mennonite World Conference (MWC): Please pray for our sisters and brothers in DR Congo. This request was submitted by Reverend Professor Érik Kumedisa (Centre Biblique Anabaptiste, Kinshasa). "For centuries, the Democratic Republic of the Congo has been plundered for its wealth and by the greed of those in power, whose sole concern is their own enrichment. This affects the way people live together and the national cohesion. In the province of Grand Bandundu, where a large number of Mennonites live, there is armed unrest between the Bayaka and Bateke tribes. In the east of the country, on the Rwanda-Burundi border, where Mennonites are gradually settling in, an armed rebellion is destabilizing the province. The collapse of the economy has given rise to tensions. Conditions are ripe for ethnic cleansing, which has already begun. Please pray for the eradication of greed and corruption, and that the Mennonite Christians of DR Congo will give an example of peace in a troubled country. We need your prayerful support."
- Multiply: Please pray for A & R, Multiply workers in Central Asia. Pray for ongoing church planting in Central Asia, long-term visa solutions, and favor in regions hostile to the Gospel.
